The race operation will be at the The Float @ Marina Bay.

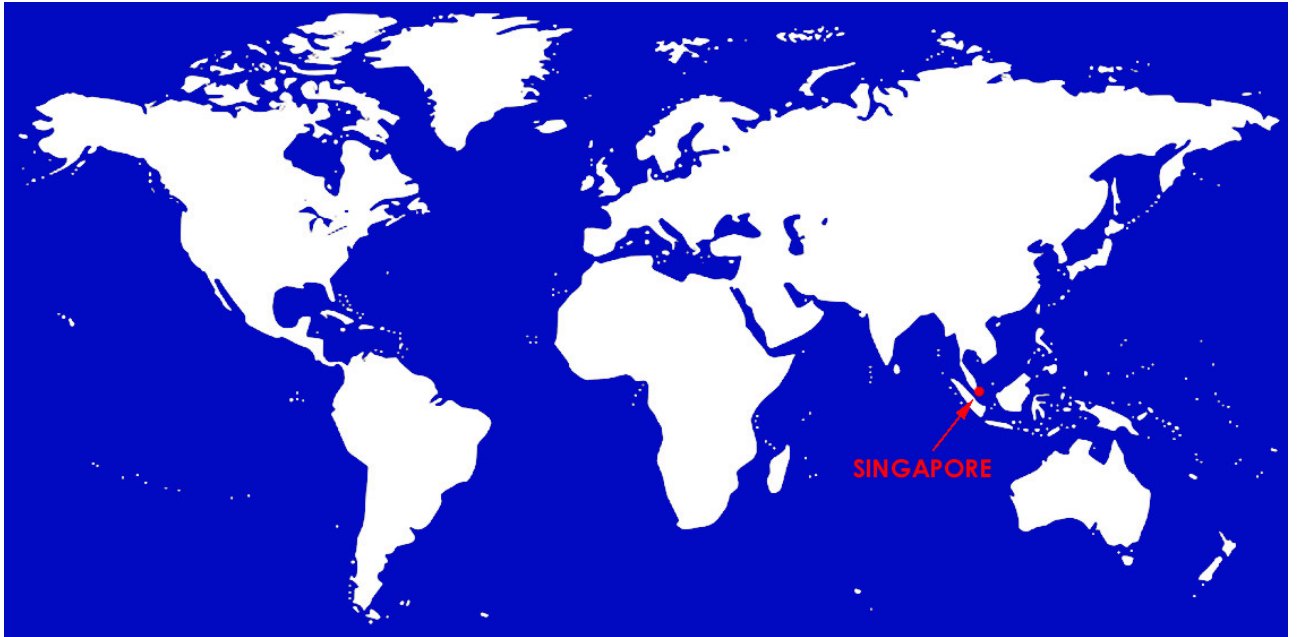

Singapore is located at the southern tip of the Asia continent, about 1 degree north of the equator. The location features summer like weather averaging 25 – 32 degrees celcius with relative humidity between 80 – 100% all year round.



The island spans about 25km from north to south and about 42km from east to west with a population of about 5 million.

Singapore's Mascot, the Merlion is a mythical creature with the head of a lion and the body of a fish. Its name combines "mer" meaning the sea and "lion". The fish body represents Singapore's origin as a fishing village when it was called Temasek, which means "sea town" in Javanese.

The lion head represents Singapore's original name — Singapura — meaning "lion city" or "kota singa".

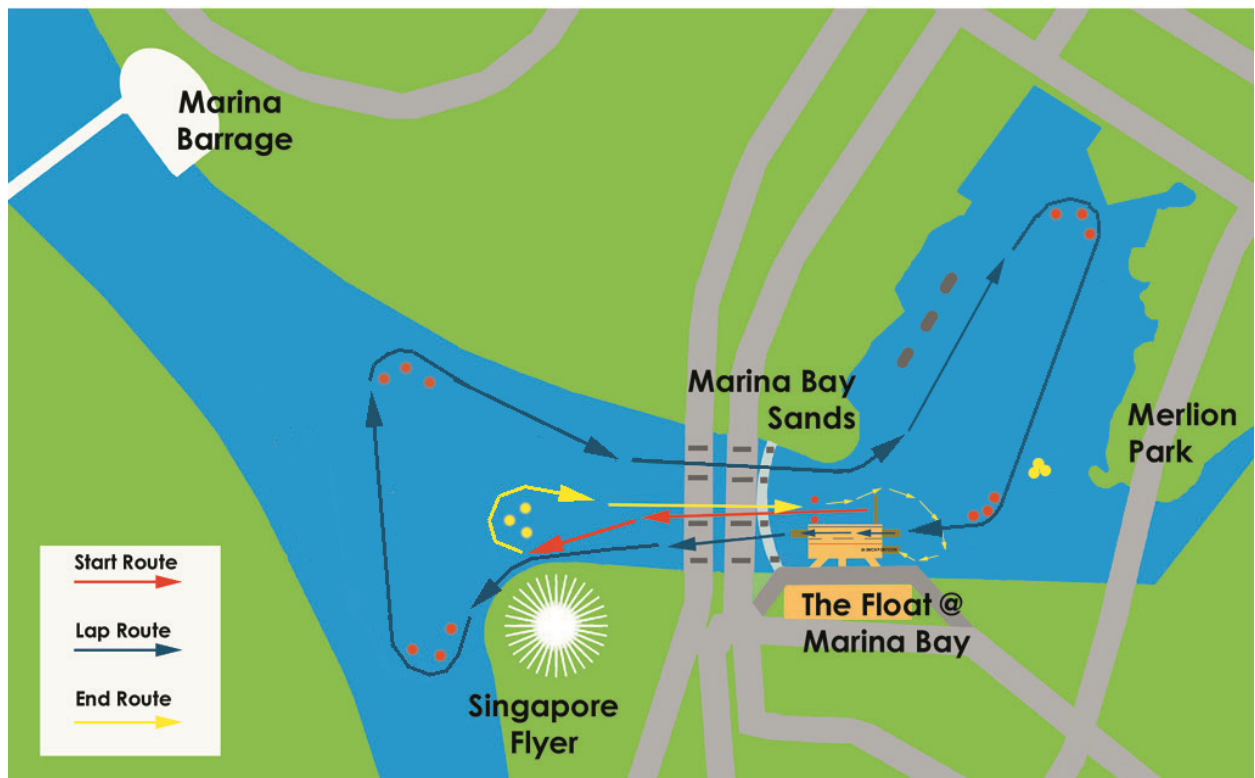

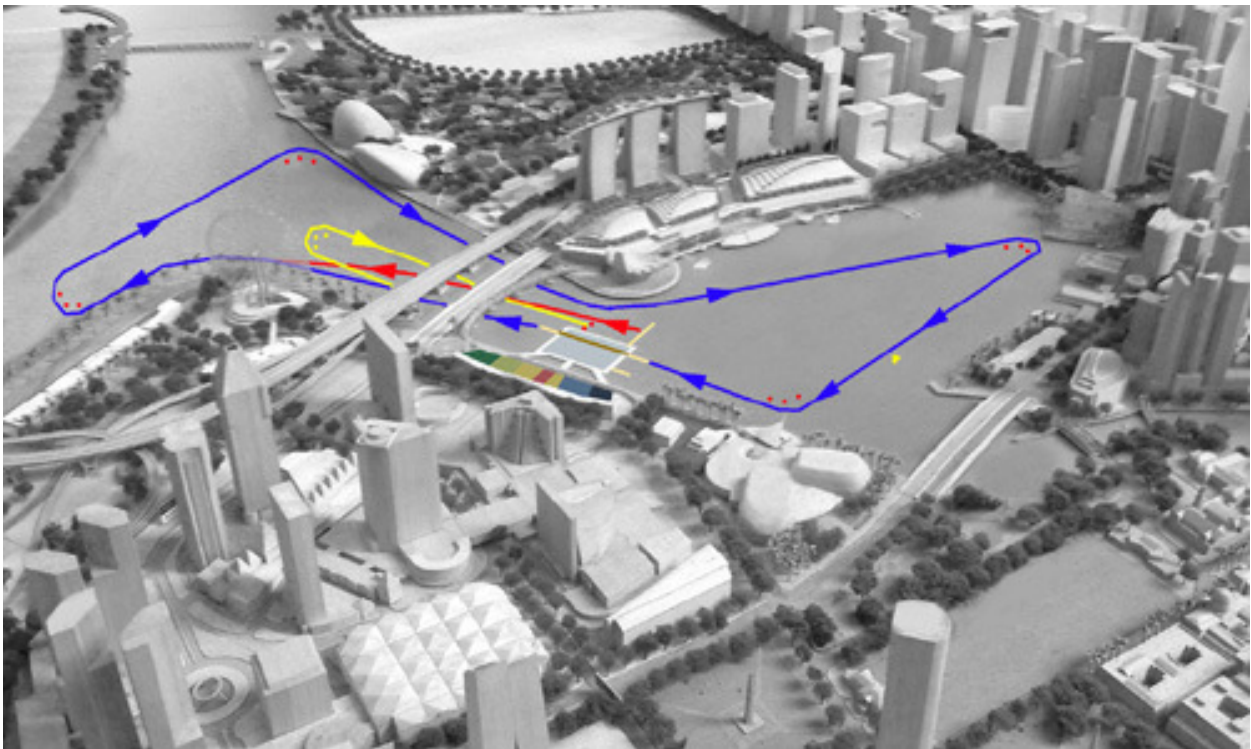

11. Boat Transportation

Transport of boats from Europe will be arranged by container from the Netherlands to Singapore and back. For details, please refer to **Annex B** at the end of this bulletin.

For other parts of the world, if your team would like to transport your own boats to Singapore, please contact the organiser with the relevant forms. The Organising Committee must be informed of all containers going to the race site to prepare for onsite storage.

All containers transported to the race site, if stored at the race site, **must be arranged to be brought to the ground without the chassis of the trailer by the respective logistics service provider**. Please link up the Organising Committee with your logistics service provider with the boat transportation form.

Containers must be brought to the site on 12th October or 13th October and must leave the race site on 24 October or 25 October.

12. Visa

Participants from countries, for which the possession of a Visa is required to enter Singapore, upon request, will receive a confirmation letter from the Singapore Canoe Federation, once their participation is confirmed.

13. Insurance

All participants are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance from their respective countries.

Annex B – Boat Transportation from Holland

The following information is from Mr. Ruud Heijsselaar of the Marathon Racing Committee.

The containers will be leaving Holland in week 35 and arriving in Singapore (Regatta course) at end of week 40 or beginning of week 41 (October 4 - 15). The container can be store at the regatta site from 12-13 October at the regatta course. The intention is to have the container in place on October 12, but see also this bulletin about access to the water before October 17.

WE NEED TO KNOW BEFORE JULY 31 2011 IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN TRANSPORT OF BOATS FROM HOLLAND.

We have to order the containers in week 31 so it will be necessary to respond as soon as possible. At the moment we are considering one 40 foot container where we can store approximately 60 boats (depending on the type of boat).

We need to know how many boats and types of boats (K1/K2/C1/C2) you intend to send to Singapore. We understand that you do not know at this moment the correct number but one or two boats less/more is not important at this time.

At the moment we have a price of appr. € 275-€ 350 a boat (depends on the total number of boats and types and if the prices of fuel and container transport will not changing). It is a non-profit making transport.

Included in this price is the following :

Transport Haarlem-Rotterdam-**Singapore**-Rotterdam-Haarlem, bunker costs, handling fee, paperwork, storage in Singapore, ATA carnet, etc.

The price is without insurance. (insurance is appr. 1,5 % of the value of the boats)

The boats are fixed in a frame (some are hanging in ropes and soft rubber on the wooden bars, so no chance of damage).

70% of the amount have to be paid to Mr. Ruud Heijsselaar before the transport leaves Holland, the other 30% before the boats arrive back in Holland (end of November).

We also need to know when you expect to arrive in Singapore (the boats of first arriving nations will be stored in the containers nearer the doors).

For all EU nations we use **one** ATA carnet (for all boats together).

We need the serial number of the boats and type and please mark the boats (on the cover) with a marker with the 3 character sign (E.g. NED, GBR). It is not necessary to fill any papers in your own country (it cost you more and is not necessary if you are living in an EU country).

For your information, all boats which are going in the container have to go back to Europe again, if not, you have to pay all extra costs (and that can be thousands of Euros)

If you are interested (or not), please inform Mr. Ruud Heijselaar before July 31 2011:

- 1) --- How many boats (K1/K2/C1/C2) and paddles you need for transport.
- 2) --- When do you have the intention to bring the boats to Haarlem (the boats will store in a boathouse for the time before the transportation). (Perhaps it is possible to arrange combined transport to Holland)
- 3) --- Which date you expect to arrive in Singapore with your team.

Other information about the way of payment, and correct place to bring the boats to will be posted later.
